The CleanScoop is a cat litter scoop with a disposable grated liner which turns the dirty job of scooping litter into an easy and clean task. Finally, a disposable liner for your cat scooper, leaving your hands free and clean to enjoy your pet!



PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

The CleanScoop is a scoop assembly that utilizes a disposable liner for lifting and disposing of animal waste. The assembly includes a scoop structure having a head section and a handle. The head section of the scoop structure has large openings. The disposable liner aligns over the large openings of the head section of the scoop structure. When **The CleanScoop** is used to scoop the soiled litter, only the disposable liner comes into contact with the waste and becomes soiled. The soiled liner can be disposed with the waste and a new liner attached to the scoop structure. **The CleanScoop** stays clean without the need of repeated washings.

Other manufactured cat litter scooper products have to be cleaned by hand or set in a plastic holder after use. Soiled litter sticks to the grates on the scooper requiring cleaning each time it is used. With the new **CleanScoop**, the soiled litter sticks to the liner and can be disposed of, leaving the scooper ready for the next clean up. After scooping the litter, the soiled kitty litter sticks to the disposable insert and can be discarded into the trash, while the frame of **The CleanScoop** can be left any where without worry of smell or soil.

Regular scoopers should be cleaned often. The soiled clumping litter that is washed down the sink drain often result in clogged drains or will cause future plumbing problems.

Toxoplasma is a disease found in litter waste that can cause birth defects in humans. Pregnant woman should not come in contact with soiled litter because of the danger of **Toxoplasmosis**.
